



## The Crump Theatre Coloring Project | Youth Art Contest

In celebration of the 131<sup>st</sup> anniversary of The Crump Theatre, the Columbus Area Arts Council (CAAC) has commissioned local artist Jenni Kiesler to illustrate two coloring pages of the historic theater. This fun and whimsical art activity was designed especially for our young aspiring artists!

Enter the Youth Art Contest, and your artwork will be featured in the poster cases outside The Crump Theatre in mid-December 2020 through March 2021. Submissions are due to CAAC by December 1, 2020.

### Here are few hints and ideas to get you started:

- Do you have a message you would like to share with our community? Use the marquee to tell us what's on your mind.
- Who do you want to see perform on the stage of The Crump Theatre? Write their name on the marquee and include a poster in the cases to help promote the show!
- Explore The Crump at night. What colors do you see on the building and in the neon lights?
- Imagine you get to design a new mural on the side of The Crump Theatre. What would it look like: an Art Deco pattern, a portrait of a historical figure, pop star, your teacher or someone who is special to you? Use the blank wall to help brighten up the building and downtown Columbus!

### How to enter the Youth Art Contest:

Complete an entry form (below) and return to CAAC by December 1, 2020. Coloring pages and entry form can be dropped in the office mail slot at 431 Sixth Street, or scanned and emailed to [info@artsincolumbus.org](mailto:info@artsincolumbus.org).

Participants must be in one of three age groups: **4 and under, 5–8, and 9–12**. A gift certificate to Viewpoint Books will be awarded to one finalist from each age group.

All submissions will be displayed in the poster cases outside of The Crump Theatre mid-December 2020 through March 2021.

### About The Crump Theatre:

Built in 1889, The Crump Theatre was the first official opera house in Columbus, Indiana. Over the last 131 years, The Crump Theatre has provided a stage for silent films and mainstream movies, performing arts, comedians and live concerts. It is now one of the oldest theaters in America, featuring an Art Deco design with neon lights.
